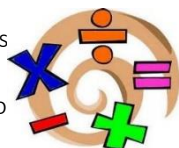


Find out below the key knowledge and skills we will learn in this topic



In Maths we will

- Learning about the values of different coins
- Count different coins and notes.
- Make different amounts using coins and notes
- Compare different amounts of money
- Calculate with money, including change.
- Solve two step problems
- Learn about multiplication and division
- Make equal groups
- Learn about the symbols for multiply and divide
- Use arrays
- Multiply and divide by 2, 5, 10



Key Vocabulary: pence, pounds, coin, note, change, total, multiply, divide, array, equal, symbols

In Computing we will

Be learning about questioning using Purple Mash, which will include looking at spreadsheets, pictograms and binary trees

Key Vocabulary: question, pictogram, data, binary tree



In Music we will



Be able to listen and appraise songs about friendship, learn new songs including "I wanna play in a band", play glockenspiels, and perform to the class.

Key Vocabulary: warm up, notes, instruments, rhythm and pulse, compose

Learning Celebration Moving Alien Encounter

In History, we will be learning about Neil Armstrong as someone who is a significant individual who contributed to international achievements. We will be recounting different aspects of his life and explaining why he was famous. We will be researching more information about him too!

In Geography, we will use satellite photographs to recognise landmarks and basic human and physical features, devise a simple map; and use basic symbols in a key.

In Science, we will identify and compare the suitability of a variety of everyday materials, including wood, metal, plastic, glass, brick, rock, paper and cardboard for particular uses. We will also find out how some materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching.

In DT, we will be designing and making a moving alien using different linkages.

In RE we will



- Retell a gospel story.
- Describe the life and work of some key figures in the history of the People of God
- Learn that God speaks to us through his words in the Bible
- Describe the life and work of John the Baptist

Key vocabulary: books, Scripture, lectern, Gospel, Bible, New Testament, Old Testament.

In PSHE we will

Learn about how families, homes, schools, the environment are different around the world.

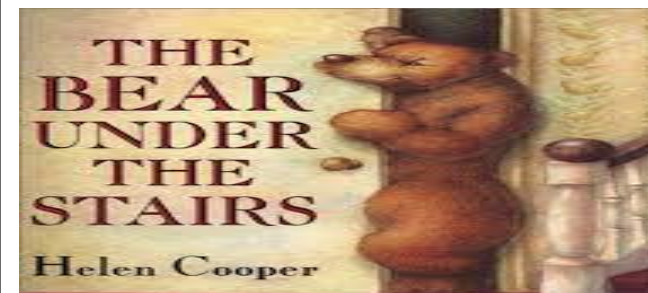

Year 2 Curriculum Overview Spring Term



Find out the key vocabulary that will be used during this topic

In English we will



Reading the book *The Bear Under the Stairs* and use it as a model to discuss their fears and how they dealt with them. The children will write letters of advice to the main character and back before writing their own story of a child who is scared of something that might be in the house. They will finish their learning by making comparisons between real bears and toy bears and using this as the basis for an information report about bears to give to William to help him feel less scared.

Key Vocabulary: Clauses, Subordinating conjunctions (using when, if, that, because), Co-ordinating conjunctions (using or, and, but), Question, Exclamation, Command

In PE we will

Learning different ball skills, including how to dribble, pass and tackle in football.

Learning how to create simple sequences in gymnastics

Key Vocabulary: dribble, pass, tackle, roll, balance
