We will be reading the story of Goldilocks and The Three Bears.

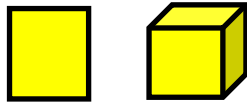

Maths

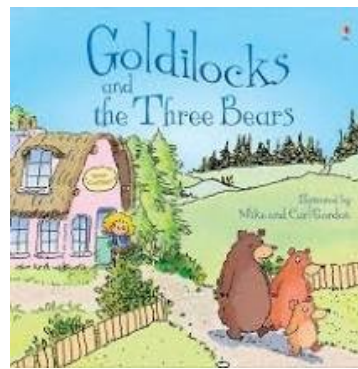
Focus shape:

Broken- when something is damaged and falls apart.

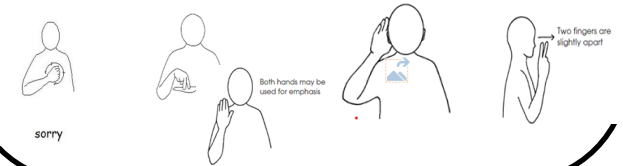
Wood - an area of land with lots of trees.
