

### Brown Bear, Brown Bear, What Do You See?

We will be going on a colour walk. What colour are the leaves. Can you find something yellow? Can you find all the colours on our list?

How can you see something very small or something very far away? We will be trying out magnifying glasses and binoculars to see if they help.

We will looking through different coloured slides to see how it changes the colour of what we are looking at. What happens when we put two colours together?
