


## Literacy- Book of the Week

### Our Special Words

**Float-** When something stays on top of the water, it floats. When something floats through the air, it moves slowly.

**Worry-** When you keep thinking about something that will make you unhappy.

**Stroke-** When you brush something gently with your hand.

**Hurry-** When you move or do something quickly because you don't have much time (quick, fast, rush, dash).


### Makaton Signs

**Being Physical-** We will be playing the 'Hurry, Hurry' game. How fast can we pass a beanbag around the circle? Can we finish before the sand timer runs out?

Focus Colour **Red**

We will be singing 'Rock-a-Bye-Baby' and 'See the Little Bunnies'.

After making calming jars (using glitter, water, and washing-up liquid) we will practise breathing slowly and gently, being calm and relaxed as we watch the glitter settle.
