We will be retelling the story using props and repeating the refrains 'I'll huff and I'll puff and I'll blow your house down' and 'Not by the hair of my chinny, chin, chin, I will not let you in'. Try sequencing the story to identify the beginning, middle and end.

We will be thinking about words that rhyme with pig; wig, dig, fig, big, gig.

One of our **golden rules** is to be kind to each other and share our toys.

Mr Wolf was angry. We will be thinking about how to manage this feeling; stop, count to ten and breathe slowly. Do you think kind words or a hug from a friend would make you feel better?

Focus Shape- Square and cubes


How many sides does a square have? How many faces does a cube have?

Learning @Pre-School



Our Special Words

Being Physical


We will be blowing bubbles. What happens if we blow fast/softly?

We will be making toast and topping it with our favourite foods.




Being Creative
