We are thinking about kind and unkind words and actions. We will be talking about what we can do if others are being unkind and how tricky situations can be resolved.

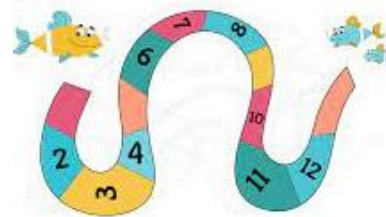


R.E.
