when comparing and ordering numbers or groups of objects.

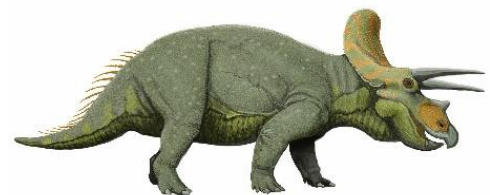
English:

What words would you use to describe this dinosaur?

We will also be ordering words to make sentences make sense, remembering where a capital letter and a full stop go.
