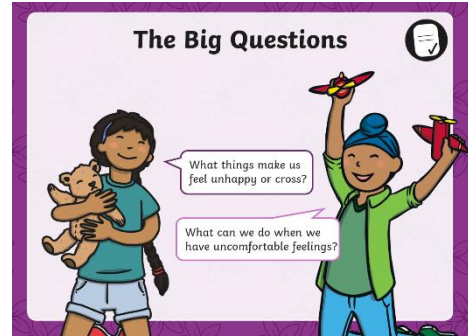
Information about some of the things we will be learning in the **Week Beginning 15th November**



P.S.H.E. Personal Social Health Education

We continue our topic on **Be Yourself**.

The Big Questions



Children will explore feelings which make them unhappy or cross and learn about the things they can safely do when they feel that way. We have to learn to manage our feelings to prevent hurting ourselves and others e.g. if you are cross and hit other people.

Children will then think of ways we can help others if they are angry or cross.

Children will add 3 things into a feelings wheel which makes them angry or cross and draw things which will help them feel better or manage their feelings.

We will listen to stories such as Jesus feeds the 5,000

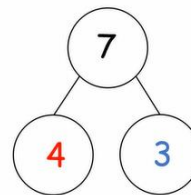


Jesus calms the storm



Maths - This week we are looking at addition fact families.

I can write 4 facts!



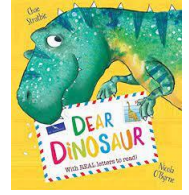
$$\begin{aligned} 4 + 3 &= 7 \\ 3 + 4 &= 7 \\ 7 &= 4 + 3 \\ 7 &= 3 + 4 \end{aligned}$$

Children will complete fact families for all numbers to 10.

English:

In English this week we continue using the book called Dear Dinosaur by Chae Strathie to find out about how letters are different to story (or narrative) types of writing.



We will look at our two dinosaur letters again to remind us of what features we need in our letter. We will also sort a letter which has been mixed up and put it in the right order. We have all chosen different dinosaurs to write to and we will tell our dinosaur why he is our favourite and use the word **because** to tell him why.

We will be using capital letters, finger spaces, full stops, our phonics to sound out unfamiliar words and our neatest handwriting.

Computing:

We are learning to use the classroom computers and will practise control of the mouse to explore Mark Making and Pattern linked to our art work.



Music: We will continue singing and clapping repeated rhythm patterns, first in songs then using percussion instruments.

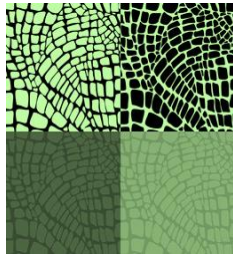


We are beginning to practise our Christmas songs.

Topic – Art

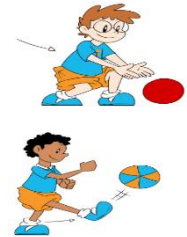
We have been exploring Pattern and Texture linked to our topic.
