In R.E. this week we will read the story of the birth of Jesus from Luke 2:1-7.


We will act out the story in groups and answer some key questions e.g.

Why was Jesus put in a manger?




Maths -

We will continue to learn about taking away / subtraction. This time we will use the part – part – whole model.




We will also look at subtraction and fact families.

$$10 - 4 = 6$$


$$10 - \square = \square$$

English:

In English this week we will look again at the book 'Dear Santa' by Rod Campbell

We will read the story again and begin to retell the story using actions to help us remember the story and we will make a story map to help them us retell the story later. We will learn how to use time connectives to help us such as 'First, Next, Then and Finally' in our writing and we will add some of the adjectives we thought of last week to make our sentences interesting. We will then tell our updated story to a partner.



Computing:

We are learning to use the classroom computers and will practise control of the mouse to explore Mark Making and Pattern linked to our art work.



Music: We will continue singing and clapping repeated rhythm patterns, first in songs then using percussion instruments.

We are continuing to practise our Christmas songs.
