## R.E. Special People

### Celebration

This week we finish the topic by thinking about all the different Special People we have learnt about.

We will choose a way of showing who is special to us and sharing why they are special.



We will recall who leads and helps people in Church and who the people were in the Presentation Bible story.

We will be joining in a school assembly celebration of Candlemas this week and have decorated candle pictures to display.



## PHSE

### Diverse Britain



Our Big Questions this week are:

*What is Britain?*

*What is it like to live in the British Isles?*

We begin with looking at Britain on a map, linking with our Geography work.

We will look at pictures of places in Britain, discussing where we do or do not like and why.

We will be looking at what people enjoy doing together, learning that whether people are similar or different to us it is important to treat all people with kindness and respect. Our differences are what makes us a diverse community and country.



## Maths

This week we will be learning about **Subtraction (taking away) by Counting Back**

Remember to count 4 jumps.

11 12 13 14 15 16 17 18 19 20

16, 15, 14, 13

$$\boxed{16} - \boxed{4} = \boxed{\phantom{00}}$$

We will be using number lines and tracks to 'jump back' along the line to complete number sentences.

Starting at the higher number we jump back to take away the second number then find out which number we finish on; this will answer our question.

We will use this method to solve some number problems.

Have a think

There were 13 muffins.  
6 muffins were eaten.  
How many muffins are left?

## English

We will begin a new story called Monkeys and Hats. We will listen to the story and retell it using repetition and actions.

We will use story maps and mountains to show our recall of the order of events. We will be adding details such as interesting adjectives which will make our retellings more exciting to hear.

We are learning how to use our own Log In information to access the school computers and the Purple Mash website independently. Learning can be supported online with Purple Mash at home.



## Music

We will continue learning the song In the Groove. We will be adding some instrumental rhythms to the song.
