R.E. Special People

This week we will continue to look at the different people who help us at Mass and remind ourselves about the different roles they have.





We will talk about the priest's special role in the church.

We will also begin to know the parish family gathers to celebrate Mass with the priest on Sunday.

PHSE

Diverse Britain

Our Big Questions this week are: What is it like in our community? How can we be good neighbours?



We will discuss the different people in our community and what they do. We will also discuss 'Who are our neighbours?' and how we can be a good neighbour to them. We will complete lots of role play on how we can help people in our community and our neighbours.

We will then complete a sorting activity to help us remember this.



Maths

This week we will be learning how we can Add by using number bonds

We begin with the first number showing how many tens and one and we then add the extra ones.

Then we will move on to using a numberline and 'jumping along' to add the second number.

We will then use our problems solving skills by answering questions such as – What is the same? What is different?

English

We continue reading the story **One Snowy Night by Nick Butterworth** – one of the Percy the Park-Keeper books. You might like to look for a youtube version of the story to share at home.





Talking about what happens to the characters and what they say, think and feel will help us to write different sorts of sentences. We will learn about the different sorts of punctuation used at the end of sentences – question marks and exclamation marks as well as full stops

Computing



In our unit on Following Instructions we will now start putting instructions into computers to perform simple tasks.

Music

We will keep learning the song In the Groove and talking about other types of Blues songs.

We will developing our Balance and Agility Skills in lessons themed on Animal Movements.
