We will discuss pictures of different environments and then spot differences in a picture. Some of us will write down ways we can help our neighbourhood.

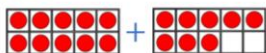


Maths

This week we will be learning how we can **Add by making 10**

Making 10

Can you help me make the number 10?



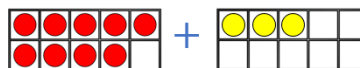
$$10 + 8 = 18$$



$$9 + 9 \text{ is equal to } 10 + 8$$

Making 10

This makes it easier to add!



$$9 + 3 \text{ is equal to } 10 + 2$$

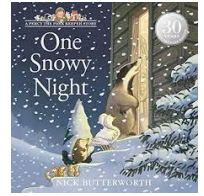
We will have to use our knowledge of number bonds to help us solve these number sentences.

When adding 9+9 (as above) we can take 1 away from the second 9 and add it to the first 9. This changes the number sentence to 10+2 which makes it easier to add and quicker to calculate.

In the second problem we do the same again take 1 away from 3 (leave 2) and add the 1 to the first 9 to make 10, So 10+2=12

English

We will complete our work on **One Snowy Night by Nick Butterworth** – one of the Percy the Park-Keeper books. Now that we have made story maps and mountains, we will use these to help us write the story ourselves.



We will include the events in order and show what the characters feel and say. Remembering to use capital letters and use finger spaces, as well as the full stops, question marks and exclamation marks we have learnt about will make our stories super to read!
