R.E.



In R.E. this week celebrate the Feast of Epiphany, remembering the story of the Wise Men's visit to the infant Jesus. We will think about the journey they made and gifts they brought. We will reflect on the gifts we can give Jesus.

What is the missing number in this sequence?

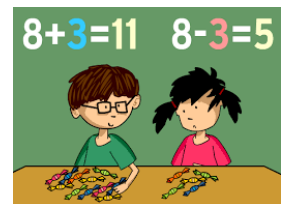
1 3 _ 7
