Special Meals: Celebrate







What are helpful and unhelpful thoughts?


What can we do if we find something challenging?

Learning new skills and practising things that are difficult can be tricky. We will attempt some challenges and talk about whether we feel positive!



Maths We are Counting in 2s and 5s to 50 and will learn to:



We continue to count in 5s using sets of objects and by looking at the pattern on the 50 or 100 square.

Measuring

We will be comparing and measuring objects and using the following words to say what we see:

long longer longest tall taller tallest wide wider widest



Using non-standard units (e.g. a pencil or a domino), we will measure different things.

English

We will be reading a new story called **No Room for Baby Roo**



As we read we will 'pause' the story and predict what might happen next. Giving reasons why we think this develops inference skills (making guesses based on what we have already read or seen). We will answer questions about this using the word 'because' to explain our thinking,



We talk about the characters in the book especially what they might feel or think.

Our mouse skills will be developed as we explore
paint programs.

Music

We will be singing along and adding improvised voice ideas and percussion to Round and Round, in a musical style called Bossa Nova. We also listen to other songs in this style.

P.E.

Please come to school in P.E. Clothes on P.E. days which are Mondays and Thursdays for Class 1J and Thursdays and Fridays for Class 1S



We develop our 'Travelling and Agility Skills' by thinking about the movements made by a train – moving at different speeds along straight lines and stopping safely.

We have started another unit which develops our jumping and landing skills – we are particularly focussing on landing safely with bent knees. This week we move over and off larger apparatus.

Topic

Science Ourselves: Our Senses

Our five senses are: Hearing, sight, smell, touch and taste.

This week we are learning about **Touch** including:

- Looking closely at hands and labelling a drawing of parts of our hand.
- Touching a variety of materials and choosing words to describe their texture (eg: smooth, rough, bumpy, cold, fluffy). We will cut and stick small pieces of these and write matching words.

Geography - Australia

Our topic that has taken us around the world and across the continents now arrives in... Australia!



We'll start by locating Australia on our world maps and discussing the distance/ways to travel there.

Then we will learn some facts about the country including:

- the flag
- natural features (eg: mountains, beaches, rainforests)
- human features (eg: buildings,
