Information about some of the things we will be learning in the week beginning 13th September 2021




English

We will be designing our own moon buggies and will then write some sentences describing them. We will also practice writing questions using question marks about what we would like to know about space. We will be using the story map we created last week for the story "The man on the moon" to innovate the story, and will begin to write our new story.

Maths:

We will practice counting objects to 100, and reading and writing numbers in both numerals and words. We will use different classroom resources to represent numbers to 100. We will be learning how to represent 'tens' and 'ones' using the part whole model.





RE: In RE this week we will be talking about how we start each new day. We will be thinking about who we greet, how we greet them and who greets us? Maybe you could also discuss at home how you begin each day together. We will then be talking about how we can greet God in prayer each morning and will be writing our own morning prayers. We will also be reflecting on our prayer tables and how we can add to these to make them to make them even more special to us.

P.S.H.E. (Personal, Social, Health Education)

We will be talking about our families and why they are important to us. We will be discussing how our families help us when we are worried or upset and how we can show our families that we care about them.
