


Year 2

Information about some of the things we will be learning in the week beginning 11th October 2021




English

We will be listening to the story "Aliens love underpants" by Claire Freedman. We will discuss what we enjoyed about the story and what was our favourite part, and will use our thoughts to write a book review. We will then be looking at what makes a good character description, and will write a character description based on personality and appearance, using different sentence openers to make our sentences more interesting.

Maths:

This week we will be using our knowledge of number bonds to 10 to help us work out number bonds to 100. For example, if we know $6 + 2 = 8$, then we know that $60 + 20 = 80$. We will be adding and subtracting 1 from any given number up to 100, moving on to adding and subtracting 10 for numbers up to 100 as well.
