English


This week we will be changing the story of "The Umbrella" by changing the setting of the story from the rainforest to the woodlands. We will change the animals in the story to different woodland animals (that we looked at last week). We will change the story map to show our new story and will use this to help us write our new innovated stories. We will focus on including capital letters, punctuation, and interesting adjectives and verbs in our stories.

Maths:

This week in maths we will continue to look at multiplication and also learning our 2 times table. We will start the week by looking at multiplication using pictures like in the picture below.

3 × 5 4 × 4

We will then move onto looking at arrays to see the different multiplication number sentences we can see which equal the same amount, like in the picture below.



RE:

This week in RE we will be listening to and learning the story of Jesus' baptism. We will look at the bible and find out where to find this story and who it was written by. As a class we will make a story map to help us re-tell the story. We will also be finding out about all the different books used at church.



PE:

This week we will be learning how to maintain our balance whilst standing on a line with a good stance. We will practise the key skills that will help us to do this; which are to keep our feet a shoulder width apart, bend our knees and to keep our backs straight and heads up. We will also lift our heels off the floor to challenge ourselves!

ICT



This week we will continue learning about spreadsheets using the 2Calculate tool on purple mash. We will learn how to use the 'Speak' and 'Count' Tools in 2Calculate to count items.

Topic - Science

This week we will be identifying and comparing the suitability of a variety of everyday materials, including wood, metal, plastic, glass, brick, rock, paper and cardboard for particular uses, by exploring the purposes of different objects. We will refer to previous learning about properties of materials to help us.
