English

Sequencing sentences to make they are in the correct order and follow the story map. Readingback over sentences to check the order makes sense.

Using our story maps from last week, to write our own woodland stories, focussing on writing a series of sentences. We will focus on using a full stop and capital letter and writing longer sentences. We will be developing our writing by increasing the quantity and detail of our sentences.

Maths

Learnng 5 and 10 times tables. Using our knowledge of counting in 5s and 10s we will to solve problems in the 5 and 10 times table.

We will learn that the X symbol means 'groups of' 'lots of' 'multiplied by'

Can you we find 5 lots of 4, 3 groups of 10, 6 lots of 2 with different things around the house?

We will be demonstrating our times tables with equipment and pictures.

How many fingers altogether?



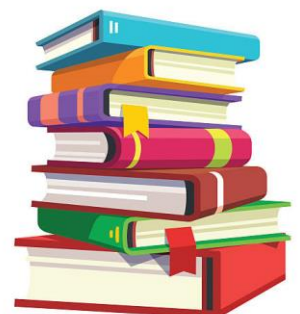
There are 25 fingers in total.
