### English

This week in English we will be working on our comprehension skills. We are reading texts including stories, poems and pieces of information and answering questions about what we have read. The children are practising how to go back and find the answer by highlighting, underlining or circling to 'prove' they are right.









### Maths

This week we are looking at 3D shapes.

Our Key Vocabulary is: Faces, Edges and Vertices. We are learning the properties of 3D shapes and sorting them accordingly. You can practice this here:

**RE:** In RE we will be learning about what happened on Easter Sunday and how Jesus rose from the dead. We will be making a class Easter garden to remember this special day. We will also be finishing our topic 'Opportunities' and so will be celebrating all that we have learnt about during our topic. We will plan a celebration where we will think about what story we have learnt about that we could listen to and activities that will also help us to remember and celebrate all that we have learnt.



**PE:** This week we will continue our learning of maintaining our balance with a partner whilst holding their hands and moving together and apart from each other. We will be doing this sitting down, standing up and with one hand. We will then be applying our skills into creating different balances that require us to lean away from each other.

## Music

This week we will use glockenspiels to perform the "Zootime" song in pairs. We will then discuss our performances, thinking about what went well and what we could improve on next time. We will also listen to the song "I Can See Clearly Now" by Jimmy Cliff, using our bodies to find the pulse. We will discuss the song and answer the questions together using correct musical language:

- How does the song make you feel?
- Does the song tell a story?
- What does the song make you think of?
- How old do you think this piece of music is?

We will also compare the song to the "Zootime" song, discussing their similarities and differences.

## ICT



This week we will learn what a database is. We will then use a simple database to answer complex search questions by using a search tool to find out the required information.

## Topic - Science

This week we will be recapping all of our fantastic learning about habitats and will complete a Habitat Quiz to see how much we have remembered. We will be learning bug hotels, and will think about what the conditions might be like in them and which insects we think would like to live there. We will be making bug hotels after the holidays, so we will be making a list of what resources we will be needing to build them.



## P.S.H.E. (Personal, Social, Health Education)

This week we will be learning about different information we might find on the internet, and that not everything on the internet is true. We will discuss examples of false information, and will try and suggest ways to find out if something online is true.
