Information about some of the things we will be learning in the week beginning 7^{th} February 2022



English

We are learning about Romel this week - a little boy who lives in the Amazon Rainforest. We will look at pictures of Rainforest tribes and be encouraged to wonder all about them. We will be using question words and question marks to write what we want to know about them. At home, can you think of any questions you would like to know the answer of and write them down?

We will follow this with reading all about them and answering some key questions.

We will then compare a day in the life at St Joseph's to living in the Rainforest - I wonder how different it will be!

Maths

How many different ways can you put them into equal groups?


Write down all the possible ways.
