BUCKINGHAMSHIRE COUNCIL ADMISSIONS STARTING SCHOOL – RECEPTION CLASS - SEPTEMBER 2024

Parents of children born between 01/09/2019 - 31/08/2020 must apply online for a school place for their child/ren from 1st November 2023.

The closing date for online applications for school places in Reception for September 2024 via the Buckinghamshire Council primary portal is on 15th January 2024.

If you are supporting your application on faith grounds, please submit a completed Supplementary Form for Bucks Catholic Schools, along with your child's original Baptismal certificate. These faith documents should be submitted via the school office to support your application by 15th January 2024.

You must apply for a school place for your child by the deadline even if your child currently attends St Joseph's Pre-School.

BUCKINGHAMSHIRE COUNCIL ADMISSIONS APPLYING FOR JUNIOR SCHOOL - YEAR 3 - SEPTEMBER 2024

Parents of children in Year 2 must apply online for a junior school place for their child/ren from 1st November 2023. The closing date for online applications for junior school places for September 2024 via the Buckinghamshire Council primary portal is on 15th January 2024. Please contact the junior school you are applying to confirm which supplementary forms and additional faith evidence they require.

INDIVIDUAL PHOTOGRAPHS (All Classes)

JS Photography have advised us that orders of individual child photographs should be delivered to school by the end of this week.

We will let you know once the photograph orders are ready to collect. We will ask you to collect and sign for your photographs from the school office.

COLD WEATHER

We please ask that pupils continue to wear the appropriate school uniform but have a warm coat and hat etc for the cold weather, together with suitable footwear for the weather conditions.

REPORTING ABSENCE (SCHOOL AND PRE-SCHOOL)

A reminder that it is important that you contact the school office at the start of the day on the first day of any absence, and then continue to keep in regular contact if the absence continues. Please use the Absence tab on your ParentMail account to send the school office a message. Alternatively the school office 24 hour answerphone service is also available for reporting your child's absence.

CHILD ILLNESS

It is essential for adult and children's health and wellbeing that pupils should be absent from school for 48 hours from the last episode of diarrhoea or vomiting if the cause is known to be viral or is unknown.

ABSENCE FROM SCHOOL

Requests for Leave of Absence during term time should not be made, in particular for holidays or extended visits to family. Absence requests should only be for truly exceptional circumstances. Parents have a legal duty to ensure their children attend school.

- Where we notice a decline in attendance, you will be notified of your child's overall attendance and the expectation to see an improvement.
- Where we have a concern, you will be requested to attend a meeting with the Headteacher to discuss your child's attendance.
- Where concerns are not addressed or parents do not work with the school to improve attendance we may refer the matter to the local authorities or the Safeguarding team.

REMINDER - HOT MEAL ORDERS FOR JANUARY 2024 - RECEPTION, YEAR 1, YEAR 2

Please remember to order hot meals via your online ParentPay account if you wish your child to receive a free hot lunch from 4th January 2024 when we return to school after the Christmas break.

The meal choices are currently available to book via ParentPay until the end of the Spring Term.

SCHOOL MILK - RECEPTION, YEAR 1, YEAR 2

Our school provides a milk scheme which is available to all pupils via our milk supplier Cool Milk. Free milk is available to order for all children under five. When a child turns five, parents have the opportunity to pay a subsidised rate for their child to continue to receive milk in school. Pupils entitled to Pupil Premium funding are entitled to free school milk.
