<p>We are learning: to know who helps us at church.</p> <p>At home: Can you tell someone at home what each person does: Flower arranger, Cleaner, Organist, Greeter, priest</p>	<p>We are learning: To retell a familiar story and begin to use speech bubbles and speech marks.</p> <p>At Home: Can you make a comic strip and add speech bubbles to show what the characters said? Can you then turn them into speech marks?</p>	<p>We are learning: to use a number line to answer questions eg. How many jumps does it take to get from 12 to 18?</p> <p>At home: Can you make a number line to 20? What is 1 more than 13? What is 1 less than 20? List the numbers greater than 16 and the numbers smaller than 12?</p>	<p>We are exploring: Different materials and magnets. Can we get a metallic object out of water without getting our hands wet?</p> <p>At home: Make a list of objects which are magnetic at home. What do you notice?</p>	<p>We are exploring: Making tuck, star and straight shapes with our body and on low equipment.</p> <p>At home: Can you make these shapes on the floor at home? Tuck - lay on your front with your knees tucked to your chest. Straight - stand straight with our arms above our heads. Star - Arms straight out at shoulder level, legs apart (looking like a starfish)</p>

	<p>We are learning: to explore colour and texture when printing. We are using lego to create patterns through printing.</p> <p>At home: What patterns can you create at home using different small objects? You can use paint, felt tip pens, colouring pencils.</p>	<p>We are learning: To find out what happens if instructions are not followed.</p> <p>At home: Ask someone in your family to draw a picture of a house without instructions. Then you draw one of your own and compare. Why do you think instructions are important?</p>	<p>We are learning: Different styles of music and this week we are learning about Latin style of music.</p> <p>At home: Listen to Livin' La Vida Loca by Ricky Martin. What instruments can you hear?</p>	<p>We are learning: What makes our Neighbourhood a nice place to live? How can we make it a pleasant place for everyone?</p> <p>At home: What do you like about your Neighbourhood?</p>
