<p>We are learning: About the presentation story and when baby Jesus was presented at the temple.</p> <p>At home: Find the story inside a children's bible and read it or watch this video version on the following link: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=1KORWnOyHRs</p>	<p>We are learning: To write a familiar story using our story maps from last week.</p> <p>At home: Can you practise writing sentences about your favourite story? Remember to use your phonics, capital letters, full stops and finger spaces. Afterwards, see if you can make your sentences even more interesting by adding adjectives.</p>	<p>We are learning: Our number bonds to 20. We will learn how to use our knowledge of other number bonds to add. E.g. $2 + 3 = 5$ and $12 + 3 = 15$</p> <p>At home: Log into Purplemash and do the maths homework set.</p>	<p>We are exploring: Different materials and finding which one is the odd one out.</p> <p>At home: Play odd one out. Select 3 objects and decide which object is the odd one out by looking at their properties eg. rough, smooth, hard, soft, rigid, floppy.</p>	<p>We are exploring: walking forwards and backwards with fluidity and minimal wobble</p> <p>At home: Can you walk with one foot in front of the other in straight line? Can you do this backwards? Keep your head up and arms out for balance. Your aim is to not wobble.</p>

Can you mix them and make secondary colours? Did they follow your instructions?</p>	<p>We are learning: Different styles of music and this week we are learning about bhangra style of music.</p> <p>At home: Listen to 'Jai Ho by A.R. Rahman What instruments can you hear?</p>	<p>We are learning: About what it is like to live in the British Isles?</p> <p>At home: What do you like about living in the British Isles?</p>
