Our new topic is Holydays and holidays. We are learning: We will be learning more about the events of Pentecost. We will create a beautiful stained glass window picture. At home: Can you find out facts about the Holyday of Pentecost - how is it celebrated around the world?	We are learning: We will be continuing to read our story "Lost and Found" by Oliver Jeffers. We are going to be researching and writing about penguins. We are then going to be writing some instructions, so we know exactly what to do if we ever find a lost penguin! At home: Can you find out any interesting facts about penguins?	We are learning: We are continuing to focus on grouping equal amounts and will use arrays to support this learning. We will use our knowledge of counting in two's, five's and ten's to calculate the total in each group or array.  At home: Can children sort their toys into equal groups?		We are exploring: How to perform a range of skills with some control and consistency.  We will practise rolling a ball to a partner with their left and right hand.  We will roll a ball to a partner from 3 or 5 metres away.  At home:  Can you roll or bounce a ball in time to your favourite song?
Geography  We are learning about: This week we will be learning more about the 4 countries that make up the United Kingdom and their capital cities.  At Home: Can you find out some fun facts about any of the countries in the UK?	Design and Technology	Computing  We are learning: How to use code to make a computer programme.  New vocabulary:  Algorithm - precise step by step instructions.  Command - A simple instruction.  At home:  Practise giving and following simple precise instructions.	Music  We are listening: To Supercalifragilistice xpialidocious from Mary Poppins At home: Listen to this song with your grown up. Can you sing it to them? What do you like about this song?	PSHE  We are learning: About positive learning attitudes.  The children will apply their amazing growth mind-sets to work practically in groups to solve tasks such as creating block models.
