<p><b>We are learning:</b> To know the parish family spends time together after mass.</p> <p><b>At home:</b> Talk about what you do after a big event, such as a wedding or christening. How do you celebrate together?</p>	<p><b>We are learning:</b> To understand what rhyming words are.</p> <p><b>At home:</b> Can you make a rhyming string using these words; Dog, Cat, Bug, Hen e.g. pig, dig, wig...</p>	<p><b>We are learning:</b> About doubles and near doubles.</p> <p><b>At home:</b> Can you double these numbers and work out these near double? 4+5= 5+6= 7+8= 8+9=</p>	<p><b>We are exploring:</b> Materials and using scientific language to describe them eg floppy, rigid, bumpy, smooth, flat, flexible</p> <p><b>At home:</b> Can you build a small house out of lego, straws, playdough and describe the properties?</p>	<p><b>We are exploring:</b> ways to travel in different shapes (tuck, straight, pike, straddle) e.g. low bunny hops for tuck, army crawl for straight.</p> <p><b>At home:</b> Show your family how to make the follow shapes tuck, straight, pike, straddle</p>

	<p><b>We are learning:</b> to make art by printing. We will be styling our art like Monet's water lily pond - <a href="#">see here</a></p> <p><b>At home:</b> Make prints at home using the technique we used in school Paint a picture with a thick layer of paint. Then use another piece of paper and press it on top of the painting to make a print.</p>	<p><b>We are learning:</b> To use the direction keys in a simple program.</p> <p><b>At home:</b> Practise using the vocabulary of forwards, backwards, left and right.</p>	<p><b>We are learning:</b> Different styles of music and this week we are learning about folk style of music.</p> <p><b>At home:</b> Listen to 'Lord of the Dance' by Ronan Hardiman. What instruments can you hear? Can you find the pulse? What is different about this music?</p>	<p><b>We are learning:</b> About how people who live in Britain are similar and different from each other.</p> <p><b>At home:</b> Think about and identify different ways you help in your community.</p>
