<p><b>We are learning:</b> How we change and grow.</p> <p><b>At home:</b> Read / listen to Jasper's Beanstalk on the following link- <a href="#">Jasper's Beanstalk</a> Talk about what happened and how the beanstalk changed. Like the beanstalk and seasons of the year we too change and grow. Talk about how different you are from when you first started school and the ways in which you have changed.</p>	<p><b>We are learning:</b> to follow and write instructions. Also learn and use imperative (bossy) verbs</p> <p><b>At home:</b> Make a poster on how to wash your hands. Write step by step instructions and add pictures. Try washing your hands first to think about what each step of the instructions will be.</p>	<p><b>We are learning:</b> to compare and measure lengths. We will be using objects to measure and then start to use centimetres.</p> <p><b>At home:</b> Find 3 different objects, order them by length. Make sure you use the language, taller / shorter / longer. Then measure each on using building bricks like lego (they need to be the same size). They try using a ruler and measure the length in centimeters.</p>	<p><b>We are understanding:</b> Water is a material and ice is water in a different state.</p> <p><b>At home:</b> Observe a block of ice. Predict what is going to happen to it when it comes out of the freezer. Then wait for 5 mins and then observe again. Has it changed? What is different? Predict again what it will look like again after 10 mins. Record your findings. With another ice cube observe again 5 mins and then 10 mins but this time add salt. Predict what will happen (it should melt quicker because salt lowers the freezing point of the water).</p>	<p><b>We are exploring:</b> How to control a ball using 1 and 2 hands. Rolling it around our body and up and down our legs when we are sitting and standing.</p> <p><b>At home:</b> Try moving different sized balls around your body making sure you control the movement of the ball.</p>

	<p><b>We are learning:</b> to assemble the components of my structure.</p> <p><b>At home:</b> <a href="#">BBC Two - Primary Focus Geography - Green Power, How does a windmill work?</a> Watch how windmills work. Can you make a windmill at home?</p>	<p><b>We are learning:</b> To know there is a difference between a story book and an e-book. To explore the tools of 2 create a story.</p> <p><b>At home:</b> Children can talk about books they enjoy at home. Do they have sound buttons? What are the differences between a paper book and an e-book?</p>	<p><b>We are listening:</b> The imperial March by John Williams</p> <p><b>At home:</b> Have a listen and see if you can play along with the beat.</p>	<p><b>We are learning:</b> To talk about things I like that makes me happy</p> <p><b>At home:</b> Talk at home about what things make you happy. Then draw or write a list of these things. Have a go at answering these questions 'when do you feel happy?' 'what other good feelings do you feel?'</p>
