<p>We are learning: About how people have special meals together and how Catholics go to Mass to celebrate a special meal.</p> <p>At home: Think and talk about a special meal you have had. Talk about what made it special, who was there and how it made you feel.</p>	<p>We are learning: What an acrostic poem is and how to put together words to form our own acrostic poem.</p> <p>At home: Can you think of a word or sentence that begins with each of the letters in Winter? E.g. W-Winter wonderland, I-Icicles N- Nothing is hot</p>	<p>We are learning: To work with numbers up to 50 - adding subtracting and finding the difference.</p> <p>At home: Practise recognising and counting numbers to 50. Try making different numbers to 50 using objects. Can you group them into tens? E.g. 20 is two tens.</p>	<p>We are exploring: Materials and using scientific language to describe them eg floppy, rigid, bumpy, smooth, flat, flexible</p> <p>At home: Can you build a small house out of lego, straws, playdough and describe the properties?</p>	<p>We are exploring How to stand on a line or low beam with a good stance for 10 seconds.</p> <p>At home: Draw a line outside or put a skipping rope on the floor. Now practise bending your knees, looking up, feet shoulder width apart, keeping your back straight and lifting your heels up.</p>

	<p>We are experimenting: with different mediums to create art - paint, drawing, chalk, crayons</p> <p>At home: Draw round shapes at home and colour them using paints, coloured pencils, crayons and chalks. Remember if the shape overlaps use a different colour.</p>	<p>We are learning: To use the direction keys in a simple program and create a simple algorithm.</p> <p>At home: Practise using the vocabulary of forwards, backwards, left and right. Make up a set of instructions to direct someone to somewhere within the house using these words.</p>	<p>We are learning: about different styles of music. This week it is hip hop.</p> <p>At home: Listen to 'It's Like That' by Run DMC. What instruments can you hear? Can you find the pulse? What is different about this music?</p>	<p>We are learning: What 'British' and living in the British Isles means.</p> <p>At home: Discuss living in Britain and talk about what makes you feel proud about Britain.</p>
