


Weekly Snapshot

In maths, we have been exploring patterns in the environment and creating our own repeating pattern using different resources such as buttons, pegs, gems, and paint. The children were able to talk about the wonderful patterns they created. In RE, we have been learning about the resurrection of Jesus and how everybody celebrates the good news. We watched the KS1 assembly about the Easter story and sang some Easter songs such as 'The Children Came with Olive Branches' and 'You made me'. We also created our own Easter gardens
