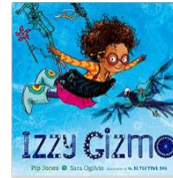

How are they different?</p>	<p>We are learning to/about: Safely use and explore a variety of materials, tools and techniques, experimenting with function. Try this at home: Make an invention like Izzy Gizmo, using the things you have a home.</p>
