

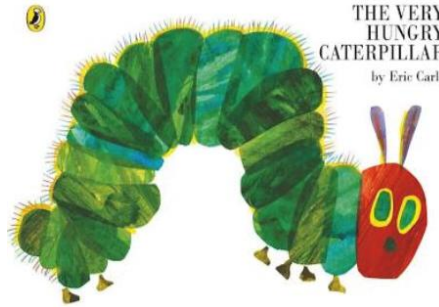
Change

Literacy

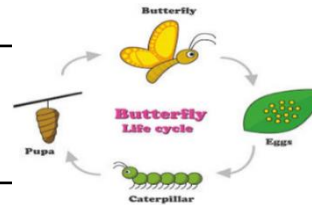


We continue to explore the book 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar'.

We will be sorting toy fruits and insects into groups with tweezers and pincers.

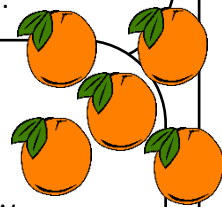
RECORD BREAKERS – We try to make the schools longest caterpillar as we stand one behind the other. We will be crawling, wiggling, shuffling and slithering.

Focus numbers – 1-5
