We will learn more about the Holy Spirit and how The Holy Spirit helped Jesus' friends, and the birth of the Church.</p> <p>At home: Can you explain to your grown up why you think Jesus sent the Holy Spirit to his friends?</p>	<p>We are learning:</p> <p>We will be continuing to read our story "Lost and Found" by Oliver Jeffers. We will be exploring similes using our knowledge of synonyms and adjectives.</p> <p>At home:</p> <p>Can you think of similes to describe waves? For example the wave was as tall as a skyscraper!</p>	<p>We are learning: To make equal groups and share numbers between 2, 5 and 10. For example we will be sharing 10 cupcakes between 2 plates. We will also explore numbers that cannot be shared by 2, 5 or 10.</p> <p>At home: Can you share something into equal groups? Maybe you can put your toys into equal groups of 5 and challenge yourself to count in five's to find the total.</p>		<p>We are exploring: How to perform a range of skills with some control and consistency.</p> <p>We are continuing to send and receive balls to our partner, making sure our partners pick it up using two hands and they return it to us using one hand.</p> <p>At home:</p> <p>Can you pass a ball with control and consistency between obstacles?</p>

We will discuss jobs that exist in the local community and the skills and interests required in order to do these jobs.</p> <p>At home: Can you talk with your family about the job you would like to do and explain why? What do you think would make you good at this particular job?</p>
