English

This week we have comtinued reading the Minpins by Roald Dahl but our focus has been on apostrophes for possession. We have been learning what they look like, what they are used for and how to use them in sentences. In addition, we have been creating facts about the Minpins using the information from the text.

Maths

Our focus has been learning about length this week. This has involved using both a ruler and a metre stick to measure a variety of different objects. We have learned how to measure accuarely and some ways we might get the measurements wrong. Finally, we have been comparing, ordering and solving problems involving length.
