Information about some of the things we have been learning at St Joseph's

in Year 2 this week. 6/11/23 to 10/11/23

Topic

This week, we have started our new topic of "A Wonderful World" through some amazing dance. We have been learning the Continents song and creating a variety of movements using different levels, actions and turns. It has been tremendous fun and we are looking forward to performing it at some point soon!

English

We have been continuing our learning linked to Jim and the Beanstalk. This week, we have been ordering events from the story and re-writing sections using a variety of different adverbials such as in the morning, the next day, after an hour of climbing and many more. We have also explored our root words (hurry) change to the past tense (hurried) and to the present progressive (hurrying). Finally, we have begun the exciting challenge of finishing the trilogy by planning the next adventure in the series.

Maths

We have continued our learning linked to addition and subtraction this week by using number lines to help us add and subtract using tens and ones. This has involved using a number line to count forwards and backwards but also using jumps to the next ten, rather than just counting in ones. For example: 27 + 5 would be solved by calculating 27 + 3 + 2 and 22 - 7 would be solved by calculating 22 - 2 - 5.
