Religious Education

We will be talking about how Jesus came to earth for everyone and how the 3 Wise Men found him by following a bright star. What might their journey have been like? They knew Jesus was special and travelled a long way.

At home you could:

Check out a map or globe of the world; can you find where Bethlehem is and where we live?

Personal, Social and **Emotional Development**

In our story Neon Leon was sad. Sometimes our friends are sad: how can we make them feel better? We will be looking at pictures of children and decide if they look happy or sad.







Physical Development

We will move like different animals in the jungle. We will be playing a game where one person is quietly chosen to crouch down and hide under a sheet: the others have to work out who is hiding! At home you could: Play a game

where a few objects are placed on a tray. One is removed and you have to think about which one is missing.

Communication and Language

Hide (camouflage) - When you go behind or under something so people can't see

Jungle (wood/ forest) - A big forest in a hot, rainy place.

Sad (upset, unhappy/miserable) - When you don't feel very happy.

Match (same, copy, identical) - When two or more things look the same, they MATCH.

Literacy

We will be counting the number of chameleons we find hiding on each page of our story.

We will be listening to the story and recalling what happened at the beginning, middle and end.


