Literacy

This week we have read a story called 'Look up'. It is about a little girl who wants to be an astronaut when she grows up. We wrote lists of things we would take to space if we were astronauts. We have been learning to read 4 tricky words - I, the, go, you (you can't sound them out!) We have also been practising our reading skills by finding the front cover, title, pictures and words in our big shared reading books.

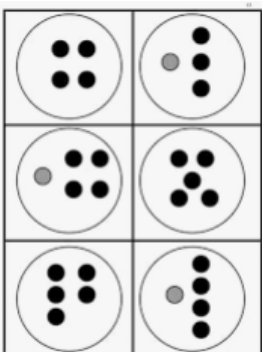
Topic

Maths

We have continued to focus on representing and subitising numbers to 5. Subitising means being able to look at a small number of objects and quickly recognise how many there are without needing to count them.

We have also learnt how to find one less and have used objects and ten frames to show 1 less. We have been saying sentences, for example, '4 is 1 more than 5'.
