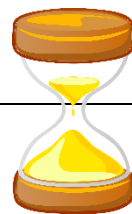

Physical Development

At home you could:

Worry- When you think about something that makes you feel unhappy you worry.

Stroke- When you brush something gently with your hand.



Hurry- (quick, fast, rush, dash). When you move or do something quickly because you don't have much time



Literacy

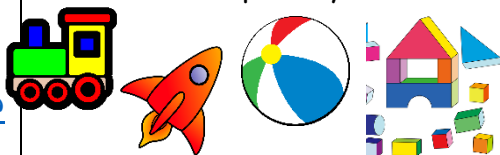

It was Tiger's birthday. What month is your birthday and what season? How old will you be?



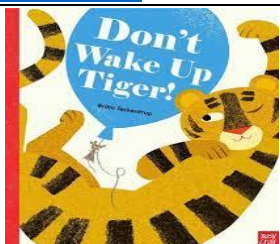
At home: Talk about what clothes you wear in winter and why.

At home: Investigate which of your bath toys float.

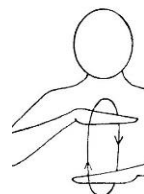
What animals like to be stroked?



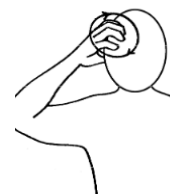
