in Year 1 this week. 15.01.24 to 19.01.24

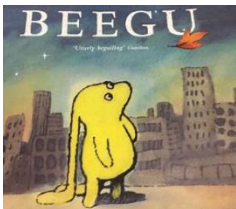
Topic

This week, topic has focussed on Science. As a class, we have discussed the different materials that toys are commonly made from. We have had the opportunity to feel and hold different toys and then identify the material. The children have used and understood an incredible range of vocabulary and descriptive language such as hard, soft, flexible and rigid.

In other areas of the curriculum Year One have had lots of fun in PE using equipment to show wide and narrow poses and move like champion gymnast!

Continuing our 'Special People' topic in R.E. the children have learnt how Jesus is the most special person for the parish family. To reinforce this the children have listened to the story of Mary and Joseph taking Jesus, as a baby, to be presented in the Temple. We retold each other this story and created a story map of the key events.



English

We have continued with our exciting book Beegu and have been deciphering her alien language and using the conjunction 'but' to write down what we think she may be saying. We explored using dictionaries to then find and write the definition of simple words.

Maths

We have been learning to use a number to 20 and finding the missing numbers on number lines. Year One have revisited key vocabulary such as 'greater than, less than and equal to'. We have compared numbers within 20 and recapped using the 'crocodile' eats the bigger number' concept.
