in Reception

## Literacy

We have started to read and write the following sounds this week - m a s d t and lots of the children have really enjoyed doing this. We are starting to see lots of letters included alongside childrens drawings. We have enjoyed the story 'Where the wild things are' and have drawn our own wild things, things they might eat and labelled them. Ask your child if they can remember something that Max did in the story.

## R.E.

This week have been learning that we all have a family that we belong to and that God loves our family too. We have been talking about the different members of our families as well as finding out that our families are all made up differently.

## Topic

This week we have used a range of creative skills to make wild things like the creatures we met in the story 'Where the wild things are'.
