English

There has been a mystery in Year One this week! 15 and 1J have investigated who could have possibly made all the mess around the school, we think it was the Naughty Bus. The children have discussed their ideas and used descriptive language to explain their findings. They have worked very hard to write sentences to caption an illustration in our class book, Naughty Bus.

Maths

We have compared numbers and amounts using practical resources. Using the mathematical vocabulary that we learnt last week we have described which is more, which is less or if they are equal. Year One have been using comparison signs and learning that 'the crocodile always eats the bigger number!'

Topic

We have been creative and artistic in out Topic lessons this week! We have been learning the 3 primary colours and how we mix them to make 3 secondary colours. The children have enjoyed using their colour knowledge to create repeating patterns and mixing colours to paint a stegosaurus.
