R.E. and Catholic Life

We have been celebrating St Paul and him spreading the good news. This serves a reminder to us as Catholics that we should be spreading our message about God and being kind to everyone we meet. As part of this, we created friendship bracelets for someone in our class to remind them that God loves them.

Topic

Continuing our theme of Sun, Sea and Sand, we have compared Aylesbury to a coastal town by looking at the physical and human features. We also learned some new facts about Aylesbury as it involved talking about some places in our local area that the children were yet to explore. We also have been making sliding mechanisms of a sunset on a landscape as part of our Design and Technology learning. These looked amazing!

Maths

We moved onto addition and subtraction this week. This has involved looking at number bonds within 10, 20 and 100. We have also been looking at the relationships between addition and subtraction by creating fact families such as 25 + 10 = 35 so 35-25 = 10. We have also been creating related facts such as if we know 2+3 = 5, then we know 20+30 = 50.

English

This has been an exciting week for Year 2 as we have been busy creating our leaflets all about wolves. This has included sections such as an introduction, what wolves look like, what wolves eat and lies about wolves. This week has given them an opportunity to use all of their previous learning on adjectives, sentence openers, conjunctions and punctuation.
