Topic

This week we have started to focus on our topic of 'Myself'. We have used mirrors to look at our faces and name the different features we can see, as well as to help us paint a picture of our face using colour appropriately.

We have also been naming and labelling different parts of our body and using different stamps to create a range of print techniques in paint.
