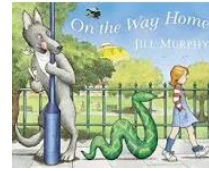

<p>We are learning to: Apply the sounds we know to our writing by using our Fred fingers to help us</p> <p>Try this at home: Practise your writing by writing a diary entry each day</p>	<p>We are continuing learn to/about: solve problems involving subtraction and number bonds</p> <p>Try this at home: write down all the number bonds for 9 & 10 e.g. 6+4=10, 8+1=9</p>	<p>We are learning to/about: features of the environment e.g shops, bus stops, parks, post box, traffic lights, school etc</p> <p>Try this at home: Make a map of the area near your home and include the different features nearby.</p>	<p>We are learning to/about: to retell the story using props and objects as well as make up new version of the story</p> <p>Try this at home: Make a puppet to show one of the characters from the story</p>
