Halving and sharing.</p> <p>Try this at home: Count out a group of toys. Can you give half to your mum or dad?</p>	<p>We are learning to/about: Name key features we see at the beach and compare the beach to other places.</p> <p>Try this at home: Look at some photos of beaches from around the world and talk about how they look similar or different.</p>	<p>We are learning to/about: Safely use and explore a variety of materials, tools and techniques, experimenting with colour and design.</p> <p>Try this at home: Make some sea creatures that you find at the beach.</p>
