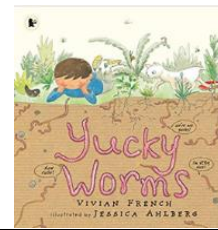

Focus story: Yucky Worms

Key Vocabulary: Yucky, Slimy, Slithering, Vanished, Wriggle, Squirm,

<p>We are learning to/about: Friends of Jesus: We can make friends and we can be a friend.</p> <p>Try this at home: Draw a picture of you and your friends. Talk about why they are your friend and what things you do together.</p>	<p>We are learning to/about: To form positive friendships with our peers.</p> <p>Try this at home: Talk about how we can make new friends and what can we do if we have a friendship fall out or problem- Talk to your teacher or family.</p>	<p>We are learning to/about: Agility- Reaction / Response. Watching the ball and moving quickly to catch the ball.</p> <p>Try this at home: Bounce a ball and see how quickly you can catch it. Try to clap your hands before you catch it.</p>	<p>We are learning to/about: Listen to stories and anticipate key events and respond to what they hear with comments, questions or actions.</p> <p>Try this at home: Talk about the story. What happens at the beginning, middle and end. Use the key words to describe the worm.</p>

<p>We are learning to: Write for meaning or a purpose. Write a friendly message to a worm.</p> <p>Try this at home: Write a letter to a mini beast. What will you say to it? What questions will you ask?</p>	<p>We are learning to/about: Subtraction- Taking away a number of items from a larger group and counting how many are left.</p> <p>Try this at home: Make up a number story by finding some objects and talking some away. How many are left? Can you record this in a number sentence?</p>	<p>We are learning to/about: Investigate earthworms and their habitats. How we care for and treat small animals.</p> <p>Try this at home: Make a wormery (house for a worm) out of a plastic container. Observe what is happening and make sure you have air holes and add some food!</p>	<p>We are learning to/about: Use different materials to create worms - clay, dough, string and paper. Learn songs/ poems and act them out.</p> <p>Try this at home: Sing the song 'There is a worm at the bottom of my garden' to your family. Make up your own worm poem or song!</p>
