Try this at home: Try hard to follow all the instructions your parents give you at home when you are being asked to do something.</p>	<p>We are learning to/about: Develop confidence, competence, precision and accuracy when engaging in activities that involve a ball. Try this at home: Practise throwing, catching and rolling a ball. Chase the ball so you can stop it.</p>	<p>We are learning to/about: To use past and present and future forms accurately when talking about events that have happened or are to happen in the future. Try this at home: Talk about holidays you have had with your family or will have in the summer.</p>

<p>We are learning to: To write simple sentences using finger spaces. Try this at home: Write some sentences about a family holiday or outing you had together. Where did you go? What did you do? Who was with you?</p>	<p>We are learning to/about: Odd or even numbers. That some quantities can be grouped into pairs and some quantities will have one left over. Try this at home: Gather some toys, explore what happens when you group them into pairs. Does everybody have a partner? Have you made even pairs or is there one left out.</p>	<p>We are learning to/about: Explain some similarities and differences between life in this country and life in other countries drawing on stories, maps and non-fiction. Try this at home: Find out some more about life in the Caribbean. Can you find The Dominican Republic on the world map and draw the flag?</p>	<p>We are learning to/about: Perform songs, rhymes and poems with others and try to move into to music. Explore music from the Caribbean. Try this at home: Perform some of the Jesus songs we have learnt with Mrs Finn to your grown-ups. Don't forget the actions!</p>
