

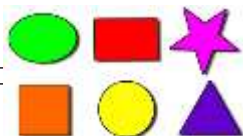
The children have grown in confidence within the new experiences they have taken part in. We continue to support them as we prepare for their transitions in September.

Can you write the initial sound on a whiteboard or find it on the sound cards?



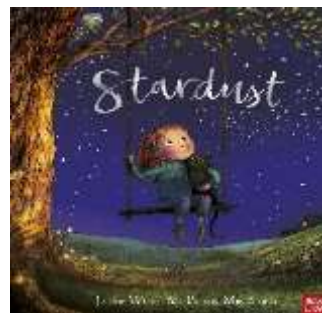
