Physical Development

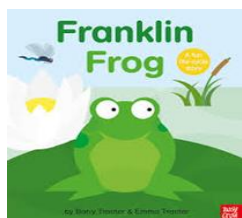
We will be practicing our jumping skills. Jumping high, far, off and over. We will be measuring how far we can jump.

Book of the Week

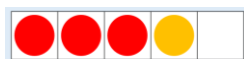


Share our rhyme of the week '5 Little Speckled Frogs'.

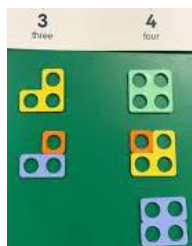

We will exploring how we can make 3 and 4 using counters and numicon.

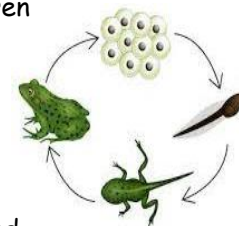


At home: Collect 3 or 4 small objects. Take it in turns to make 3 can you try 4? (2+1 +1, 2+2, 1+1+1+1)
