

Special Words This Week:

Share - (give out, split, divide) when we let people play with some of our toys or have some of our food, we are sharing.

Reach - (get, stretch) when you stretch your arms to try to get something.
Kind - (nice, friendly, thoughtful) when you are nice to people, you are kind.

We will be decorating our Lenten tree with hearts and thinking about the kind things we do.




At home: Can you do something that is kind or helpful for Lent?

Physical Development


The children will be going on a Jungle Adventure exploring how animals move using lots of different stretches, balancing and catching.

At home: Can you go on a treasure hunt and describe the shiny materials you find. Are they silky, rough, smooth, flat or bumpy?


