English

Moving on from the story, The Bear Under The Stairs, we have been learning about different types of bears and written a section of a report about bears. This has included thinking about their appearance, diet and other interesting facts. We have also been focusing on editing and how we can check our work for full stops, capital letters, spellings as well as checking for sense. At the end of the week, we did some creative writing based on an image. One image was a gigantic egg, which had hatched!

Maths

We have continued our new learning this week linked to multiplication and division. This has included looking at how multiplication links to grouping and sharing. We have explored the two times table and we have seen how we can use different number sentences to make the same number eg. 5 multiplied by 4 equals 20 and how 2 multiplied by 5 added to 2 multiplied by 2 is also 20.
