Maths

We have looking at place value, where we have been using practical equipment and pictorial representations to show our understanding of what a number means. However, we have then been challenging ourselves to learn how to flexibly partition numbers. This means that 56 is 50 + 6 but it can also be 40 + 16 or 23+23.
